#### Changes to Rules

The WCF Association Croquet Laws Committee has produced a draft of the 7<sup>th</sup> Edition of the AC Laws. In accordance with WCF Statute 132.5.3, this draft is required to be placed before Members for formal consultation for at least two months before the ACLC is permitted to recommend a draft to the WCF Management Committee for submission to Council for approval.
