together with the **GC General Tournament Conditions** adopted by The Tasmanian Croquet Association (Croquet Tasmania).

Play will be under the current **Rules of Golf Croquet** as determined by the ACA and found on the Australian Croquet Association Website (https://croquet-australia.com.au/)

The competition is only open to members of Tasmanian Croquet Clubs which are affiliated to the Tasmanian Croquet Association.

All competitors will enter the Open Medal Event. On the closing date the Tournament Managers will list the entrants in handicap order and then put them into one of three approximately equal-sized Groups according to their handicap.

Group 1 might correspond roughly to A Grade, Group 2 to B Grade and Group 3 to C Grade.

Players will be notified which group they are in prior to the competition.

The Winner in Group 1 will be awarded the Tasmanian Gold Medal. The Group 2 winner will receive the Silver Medal and the Group 3 winner the Bronze Medal.

### **Special Conditions:**

All competitors will enter the Open Medal Event. On the closing date the Tournament Managers will list the entrants in handicap order and then put them into one of three approximately equal-sized Groups according to their handicap.

Group 1 might correspond roughly to A Grade, Group 2 to B Grade and Group 3 to C Grade.

The Group 1 winner will receive the Tasmanian Gold Medal.

The Group 2 winner will receive the Silver Medal

The Group 3 will receive the Bronze Medal.

Players will be notified which group they are in prior to the competition.

Playing Conditions (Some depend on the number of entries received)

- 1) 13 or 19 point games
- 2) Trying for at least 5 games per day.
- 3) Most likely in blocks with finals Sunday
- 4) Starting 8am and finishing maybe 7pm Friday & Saturday
- 5) Starting 8am & finishing by 3:30pm Sunday
- 6) Self-catering Morning and Afternoon teas by Gold Coin donation
- 7) \$5.00 lawn fees payable on the day to the host club
- 8) Entry fee \$15.00 per player
