Divisional Structure and Handicap Ranges

As for the 2021 Autumn Pennant the 2021 Spring Pennant consisted of three divisions. Handicap ranges for all divisions remained the same as for the Autumn Pennant - Division 1 -6 to 20, Division 2 5 to 20 and Division 3 10 to 20.
